Primary Function

The primary function of the Fleet Maintenance Technician I is to perform preventative maintenance and minor repairs of all apparatus and equipment assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- High School Diploma or GED equivalent
- Possess and maintain a valid Arizona Driver License with good driving record
- One (1) year work experience in heavy truck field
- Must have basic tools
- ASE certification in at least 2 areas

****Note:** Must be able to obtain Class B CDL with tanker and air brakes within one (1) year of appointment to the position.
