Develops, administers, and maintains department databases to ensure security, accuracy, and efficiency. Provides support for databases running on several platforms to enable user access to data. Trains, guides, and mentors' others on how to access data and how to make the best use of its contents. Interacts with individuals at all levels within and outside of the organization to resolve technical and non-technical issues.
