

GOLDER RANCH FIRE DISTRICT CIHP TREAT AND REFER WORKFLOW



Field Crew identifies a possible patient candidate for CIHP Program while on-scene of a 9-1-1 call related to COPD, CHF, DM, or PNA, or Pt has a PMH of MI.

Pt is not suffering an acute medical emergency and meets the refusal guidelines in the GRFD Patient Refusal of Transport AO.

Field Crew provides detail of the CIHP.

If patient consents to referral, outcome is documented as "Treat and Refer", and "Field Referral" form is sent to 40 hr CIP.

40 hr CIP reviews request and validates pt candidate fits within program parameters.

40 hr CIP initiates program paperwork and makes initial pt contact.

40 hr CIP contacts pt to inform them they do not qualify for enrollment.

40 hr CIP determines pt does NOT meet program parameters and informs Field Crew of determination

If pt declines, 40 hr CIP sends information back to Field Crew of outcome.

If pt agrees, pt is "enrolled" in program and 40 hr CIP schedules visits per normal routine. Pt will be followed for a maximum of 30 days, per referral.

40 hr CIHP sends information back to Field Crew about pt's enrollment.
