### Firefighter Survival

#### **Task/Performance Outcome:**

Individually, or as a member of a team, the candidate shall be able to manipulate their body, SCBA ensemble, and equipment to move through various fire ground obstacles under obscured vision conditions simulating an IDLH environment. The candidate must be able to recognize a mayday situation, make the appropriate mayday radio communications, and implement GRAB-LIVES procedures. Potential reasons for a mayday in this evaluation include:

- Personal air emergency
- Air emergency of another firefighter
- Lost off hose line within a structure or trapped in some capacity
- Floor collapse
- Entanglement

Throughout this evaluation, team integrity must be maintained if working as a member of a team, the mayday situation must be mitigated, respiratory protection must always be maintained, and all members must be accounted for upon exiting the structure.

#### **Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):**

Full turnout ensemble and full SCBA ensemble on air.

#### **Required Equipment:**

- Radio for each firefighter
- Flashlight for each firefighter
- Irons to door
- Axe or Halligan Interior
- Thermal Imaging Camera (Captain)

#### **Critical Fail Criteria:**

Failure consists of the following:

- Failure to be seated and belted upon arrival.
- Failure to wear the required PPE.
- Failure to physically address their accountability on the passport of their assigned apparatus.
- Failure to exit the apparatus safely and with three points of contact.
- Glaring, gross errors, as documented by the evaluator.
- An apparent lack of efficiency and comfort with the activity, as documented by the evaluator.
- Less than 80% of available points scored.

#### **Evolution Details:**

The candidate should be prepared to accomplish any of the scenarios within this skill sheet. The candidate will perform this evolution individually or as a member of a team. All necessary equipment required to successfully complete this evolution will be provided to the candidate.
