Hoisting Equipment

Standard:

NFPA 1001: 4.1.2, 4.3.20 (2019 Edition)

Task/Performance Outcome:

Hoist a tool and/or piece of equipment using ropes and the correct knots. The candidate shall demonstrate the ability to tie an approved knot and hoist a tool or piece of equipment to a designated height, as specified by the evaluator.

Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

Class C Uniform, helmet, structure gloves.

Required Equipment:

- Utility Rope
- Roof Ladder
- Hose line w/ nozzle
- Power Saw
- Axe
- Pike Pole

Critical Fail Criteria:

Failure consists of the following:

- Failure to wear the required PPE.
- Failure to physically address their accountability on the passport of their assigned apparatus.
- Glaring, gross errors, as documented by the evaluator.
- An apparent lack of efficiency and comfort with the activity, as documented by the evaluator.
- Less than 80% of available points scored.
