Ladder (Roof) Deployment

Standard:

NFPA 1001: 4.3.6 (2019 Edition)

Task/Performance Outcome:

Following the cleaning and inspection of a roof ladder, you must deploy it using the one-person shoulder carry method, following manufacturer and district guidelines. Once deployed, the ladder should be operationally ready for climbing.

Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

Full turnout ensemble, full SCBA ensemble on air (prior to climbing the ladder).

Required Equipment:

- Radio for each firefighter
- Flashlight for each firefighter

Critical Fail Criteria:

Failure consists of the following:

- Failure to be seated and belted upon arrival.
- Failure to exit the apparatus safely and with three points of contact.
- Failure to wear the required PPE.
- Failure to physically address their accountability on the passport of their assigned apparatus.
- Glaring, gross errors, as documented by the evaluator.
- An apparent lack of efficiency and comfort with the activity, as documented by the evaluator.
- Less than 80% of available points scored.

Evolution Details:

The candidate will be provided a roof ladder, which is placed flat on the ground. The evaluator will provide the candidate the exact location the ladder is to be deployed. The candidate shall deploy the ladder.

Candidate starts on the side of ladder facing the tip	1	
Candidate verbalizes Beaming Ladder and finds center of gravity	1	
Candidate lifts ladder into one-person shoulder carry position facing the butt	1	
Candidate verbalizes Checking for Overhead Obstructions & physically does it	1	
Candidate verbalizes Ladder Moving Forward, & physically does it	1	
Candidate uses arm to raise ladder parallel to the ground	1

Candidate safely brings the ladder down and returns it to the starting position	1
