Task/Performance Outcome:

Traditional Suppression Apparatus Configuration:

 Upon notification, the candidate shall be able to safely respond to the apparatus and don the necessary PPE, SCBA components, and safety devices within 80 seconds. At the 80 second mark, the candidate's door should be closed, and the vehicle should be ready to respond within the 80 second timeline established by NFPA 1710.

Cancer Reduction Cab (CRC) Suppression Apparatus Configuration:

• Upon notification, the candidate shall be able to safely respond to the apparatus and don the necessary PPE and safety devices within 80 seconds. At the 80 second mark, the candidate's door should be closed, and the vehicle should be ready to respond within the 80 second timeline established by NFPA 1710.

Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

Class C Uniform

Required Equipment:

- Full turnout ensemble
- Full SCBA ensemble
- Radio
- Flashlight

Critical Fail Criteria:

- Failure to be seated and belted upon arrival.
- Failure to wear the required PPE.
- Failure to physically address their accountability on the passport of their assigned apparatus.
- Failure to enter the apparatus safely and with three points of contact.
- Glaring, gross errors, as documented by the evaluator.
- An apparent lack of efficiency and comfort with the activity, as documented by the evaluator.
- Less than 80% of available points scored.

Evolution Details:

The candidate will be provided an apparatus to place all their PPE, SCBA ensemble, and equipment on. The apparatus will be equipped with all the necessary safety features to complete this evolution. Upon notification, the candidate must safely respond to the apparatus, don the necessary PPE for their suppression apparatus configuration, their safety devices, and have the door to the apparatus closed. When the candidate is done, they must clap their hands for the time to stop.
