The Golder Ranch Fire District is seeking qualified candidates who desire to fill the role of Lead Fleet Maintenance Technician. This is a 40-hour position based at the North Administrative offices and will report to the Fleet Maintenance Supervisor. EXPERIENCE, TRAINING/EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must have two (2) years of experience in a supervisory role, or comparable experience supervising others.
- Any combination of training, education, and experience equivalent to five (5) years full-time, journeyman-level automotive, and/or heavy-duty mechanic experience.
- Must possess current certifications as outlined by the Emergency Vehicle Technician (EVT)
 Certification Commission (evtcc.org/tracks) for the following:
 - EVT Fire Apparatus Technician Levels I, II, and III
 - Ambulance Technician Levels I, II, and III
- Must have a complete set of mechanics' tools.
- Must possess a valid Arizona Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class-B CDL with tanker and air brake endorsements with acceptable driving record.
- High School Diploma or GED
- Must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.

Preferred Qualifications

- Work experience as a mechanic with fire apparatus repair work.
- Work experience as a mechanic with ambulance repair work.
